In *Make Way for Music*, families will sing, dance, and move their way through an exploration of several elements of music: beat and rhythm, concepts and contrasts (such as staccato and legato, high and low, the major scale, and arpeggios), the human voice, instrument families, and ensemble. They'll engage in developmentally appropriate activities that the whole family can enjoy together, including fingerplays, songs, circle dances, story time, and family jam.

**Home Materials:** Two books—*Drum Circle* and *Animals on Parade*, two Home CDs, Family Guide, an instrument-matching board game and two fingerdrums.

#### POLICY

**Tuition and Registration fee** is due by the first lesson or class. **Materials Fee** must accompany the Registration for Kindermusik classes. **Two weeks advance payment ensures that Materials will arrive in time for the first class.** NOTE: If you enroll your child in both Fall and Spring semesters, paying in full by the first class in the fall, you will not be charged the spring registration fee. Please make checks payable to "School of Creative Arts" or "SCA" and mail with registration forms to: School of Creative Arts, P.O. Box 61, Lexington, MA 02420.

Please note that there is a \$25 fee for returned checks.

If a **payment plan** is needed, you must request one from the SCA director, Nancy Gerber, before classes or private lessons begin.

Your **additional financial contributions to SCA** are tax-deductible and help families with limited means take our classes.

**Some financial aid is available.** You may request a financial aid application by calling: 339-234-0774.

**Discounts:** You may take a \$20 discount for each sibling who registers for a class. (This does not apply to Family Time, which has its own built-in discount). You may also take a \$10 discount for each student you refer to SCA who registers for a Kindermusik or Theatre class.

**Reimbursement policy:** Registration fees are non-refundable. Withdrawal before first class refunded 100%. Before second class refunded 75%. **No refunds after the second class.**

There are no make ups guaranteed for student absences from classes or private lessons. Teacher absences will be made up. In case of severe illness, please contact the SCA Director, Nancy Gerber.

Class enrollments are limited, and are filled in order of registration receipt and will be filled based on teacher availability. Class schedule and calendar are subject to change.

**Kindermusik Village** is for lap babies, crawlers, and walkers. It incorporates the most current research on early childhood development and provides families a special place for learning and connecting with other parents and babies through music and movement. These units contain hallmark variety, including upbeat activities, an array of intimate lullabies, and lots of stimulating and age-appropriate objects and instruments for Baby to explore.

**Cock-a-doodle-Moo!** -- Hop on the hayride—it's time to head for the farm! In this class, you will sing songs about the farm, including "Old MacDonald," "Hayride," and "Clever Cows." You'll engage in rituals and playful activities with your baby, including infant massage, lap bounces, exercise, and quiet time. **Home Materials:** A picture board book with charming farm animals and the sounds they make—Cock-a-doodle-Moo, a CD of the songs heard in class, a Sunshine Jingle instrument for music-making at home.

**Dew Drops** -- Stop and smell the roses—and lily of the valley, and tulips, and pansies. In this class, parents and babies will play and move together to songs about flowers, such as "Jasmine Flower," "How Does Your Garden Grow?," and "White Coral Bells." You'll also hear traditional Irish music, dance a jig and move to the "Irish Trot." **Home Materials:** CD of beautifully arranged songs from class, a board book of colorful flowers—Dew Drops, a set of Art Banners for the nursery wall, and a Flower Bells instrument for music-making at home.

**Kindermusik Our Time** encourages toddlers to uncover an engaging musical world while building confidence, self-control, and communications skills. Singing, imitating sounds, rhyming, and object identification foster language skills, while creative movement to various musical "moods" develops a sense of balance, timing, and spatial awareness. Listening and turn-taking encourage blossoming social skills. *Kindermusik Our Time* reflects the emotional foundations of school readiness and the latest research on music and early childhood development. *Our Time* is a unique opportunity for parent and child to interact and learn together in an unhurried and joyful manner.

**Away We Go!** -- Hop on the train, get in the car, board the plane, and Away We Go! This class focuses on transportation, a favorite topic for toddlers who are on the go, go, go! Sing and play along with favorite songs, such as "I've Been Workin' on the Railroad" and "Wheels on the Bus". Explore fast and slow, smooth and bumpy, and high and low. Read stories about ways to get around. Shiny Dinah tells the story of a train, and Giddy-Up! has a horse, speedboat, racecar, and more to help you get where you want to go. **Home Materials:** Double CD featuring songs from class; two interactive story books—Shiny Dinah and Giddy-Up! to develop early literacy skills; Home Activity Book, and two harmonicas designed for toddlers.

**Kindermusik Imagine That!** takes the preschooler on a musical journey of discovery and exploration...a journey limited only by the power of imagination. Pretend play activities are integrated with music, vocal development, storytelling, movement and literature to capture the preschooler's potential to learn, and to encourage cognitive and literacy skills, creativity and individuality.

Designed for active, energetic, enthusiastic, and imaginative children ages 3 to 5, Imagine That! classes encourage socialization, sharing, and participating in group activities. Singing becomes a focus for enhancing the preschooler's vocal development as expressive language is just beginning to emerge. The parent and child have fun participating together in the last 10-15 minutes of class during Sharing Time, where they'll also learn about Home Activities they can enjoy together throughout the week

**Toys I Make, Trips I Take** -- Think of it as taking a course inside a child's imagination. We'll use the theme of a toy shop to make our pretend-creations, using rhythm and songs with every imaginary saw, hammer, and nail. The result is building the preschooler's sense of a sequence of events, which is good for storytelling, as well as making his ideas a reality. **Home Materials:** Two books—*If I Had a Big Blue Boat* and *Tippity Tippity Too*, Toys I Make, Trips I Take Play Set, Two Home CDs, Family Activity Book, and a drum.
